RULES & REGULATION OF THE COLLGE

The Rules of discipline shall include the following:

- Every student shall wish the Principal and the staff on the occasion of their first meeting of the day, within the college precincts.
- If a member of the staff enters the classroom, the students shall rise and remain standing, till they are directed to sit or the teacher takes his seat.
- No student shall be allowed to leave the classroom without permission or until after the teacher has left the room
- Every student should be in the college premises before 9.30.am The late - coming will be seriously viewed by the authorities Late comers have to sign in a separate register.
- Prayer will be conducted daily from 9.30.am to 9.45.am by the students.
- Students moving from one class to another shall do so in an orderly manner and with as little noise as possible.
- Students are forbidden to displace or meddle with the furniture of the college. Any damage done will be charged collectively from the students.
- Students shall not engage themselves in any political or communal activity. Severe disciplinary action will be taken against those who disturb the calm atmosphere of the college.
- Cell phone is strictly prohibited.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES

- All applications for leave with details such as the period and the causes should be submitted to the Principal in the prescribed form, at least a day before the leaves is required.
- (i) Leave may not be granted for more than seven days at a time excluding Sundays and other holidays. However, leave will not be granted for more than fifteen days in a year.
- (II) Leave on medical grounds will be considered only on production of a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
- Students are strictly warned against being absent without proper leave application.
- No candidate shall be admitted to the B.Ed degree examination unless put in 90% of attendance in each semester.
- In case of shortage of attendance, application for condonation may be forwarded to the University.

RULES FOR LIBRARY

- The College library is kept open from 9.am to 5.pm, on all working days.
- Students should observe strict silence in the library.
- Students should not bring any personal belongings to the library.
- Each student will be issued with three tokens for borrowing books.
- For borrowing books from the library, the student must produce library tickets.
- A student who borrows or returns a book must conduct the transaction by himself / herself at the library.
- Students should not keep the library book for more than the stipulated period of one week.
- Students should return all the books during the summer holidays.
- Reference books like dictionaries and encyclopedia are not meant for lending.
- Permission will not be granted for issuing magazines and newspapers from the library.
- Books and periodicals should be handled with care.
- Writing and underlining in the library books, are strictly prohibited.
- On receiving the books, the students must examine them and report to the librarian of any damage.
- In case of damage or loss of a book, the student should either replace it or pay the current cost of it. along with a penalty.
- In case of loss or damage of token, new tokens will be issued against payment of a penalty of Rs.5.00
- No student shall lend the library tickets of others.

RULES FOR THE STAFF

- Staff Members Are Eligible To Retain the books for a week, but can extend it upto a period of one month.
- Books are to be produced in the library for renewal within the stipulated period

RULES FOR HOSTELERS

- Hostelers are instructed to keep the premises neat and clean.
- The inmates should clean the hostel room weekly once which should be supervised by the co-warden.
- The residents are asked to use electricity sparingly and switch off lights and fans when they leave their rooms failing which they will be heavily fined.
- Hostelers are instructed not to throw waste materials like hair balls into the wash basin instead of dust bim.
- Hostelers are not permitted to take the food from the dining hall to rooms or the lawn.
- The approved visitors with visiting cards affixed with their Photographs alone are permitted to visit their wards.
- Breakfast will be available between 8.15.am and 8.45.am. only. Lunch will be served up to 2.00.pm daily. Dinner will be served from 7.30.pm to 8.00.pm.
- Students themselves should make provision for personal utilities like candles during power failure, cleaning powder, washing powder, etc.
