RULES & REGULATION OF THE COLLEGE

The Rules of discipline shall include the following :

1. Every student shall wish the Principal and the staff on the occasion of their first meeting of the day, within the college precincts.
2. If a member of the staff enters the classroom, the students shall rise and remain standing, till they are directed to sit or the teacher takes his seat.
3. No student shall be allowed to leave the classroom without permission or until after the teacher has left the room
4. Every student should be in the college premises before 9.30.am
The late - coming will be seriously viewed by the authorities
Late comers have to sign in a separate register.
5. Prayer will be conducted daily from 9.30.am to 9.45.am by the students.
6. Students moving from one class to another shall do so in an orderly manner and with as little noise as possible.
7. Students are forbidden to displace or meddle with the furniture of the college. Any damage done will be charged collectively from the students.
8. Students shall not engage themselves in any political or communal activity. Severe disciplinary action will be taken against those who disturb the calm atmosphere of the college.
9. Cell phone is strictly prohibited.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES

1. All applications for leave with details such as the period and the causes should be submitted to the Principal in the prescribed form, at least a day before the leave is required.
2. (I) Leave may not be granted for more than seven days at a time excluding Sundays and other holidays. However, leave will not be granted for more than fifteen days in a year.
3. (II) Leave on medical grounds will be considered only on production of a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
4. Students are strictly warned against being absent without proper leave application.
5. No candidate shall be admitted to the B.Ed degree examination unless she has put in 90% of attendance in each semester.
6. In case of shortage of attendance, application for condonation may be forwarded to the University.

RULES FOR LIBRARY

1. The College library is kept open from 9.am to 5.pm. on all working days.
2. Students should observe strict silence in the library.
3. Students should not bring any personal belongings to the library.
4. Each student will be issued with three tokens for borrowing books.
5. For borrowing books from the library, the student must produce library tickets.
6. A student who borrows or returns a book must conduct the transaction by himself / herself at the library.
7. Students should not keep the library book for more than the stipulated period of one week.
8. Students should return all the books during the summer holidays.
9. Reference books like dictionaries and encyclopedia are not meant for lending.
10. Permission will not be granted for issuing magazines and newspapers from the library.
11. Books and periodicals should be handled with care.
12. Writing and underlining in the library books, are strictly prohibited.
13. On receiving the books, the students must examine them and report to the librarian of any damage.
14. In case of damage or loss of a book, the student should either replace it or pay the current cost of it, along with a penalty.
15. In case of loss or damage of token, new tokens will be issued against payment of a penalty of Rs.5.00
16. No student shall lend the library tickets to others.

RULES FOR THE STAFF

1. Staff Members Are Eligible To Retain the books for a week, but can extend it upto a period of one month.
2. Books are to be produced in the library for renewal within the stipulated period

RULES FOR HOSTELERS

1. Hostellers are instructed to keep the premises neat and clean.
2. The inmates should clean the hostel room weekly once, which should be supervised by the co-warden.
3. The residents are asked to use electricity sparingly and switch off lights and fans when they leave their rooms failing which they will be heavily fined.
4. Hostellers are instructed not to throw waste materials like hair balls into the wash basin instead of dust bin.
5. Hostellers are not permitted to take the food from the dining hall to rooms or the lawn.
6. The approved visitors with visiting cards affixed with their Photographs alone are permitted to visit their wards.
7. Breakfast will be available between 8.15.am and 8.45.am. only. Lunch will be served up to 2.00.pm daily. Dinner will be served from 7.30.pm to 8.00.pm.
8. Students themselves should make provision for personal utilities like candles during power failure, cleaning powder, washing powder, etc.
